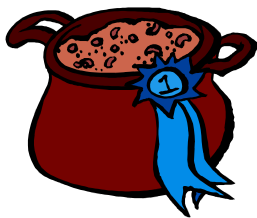
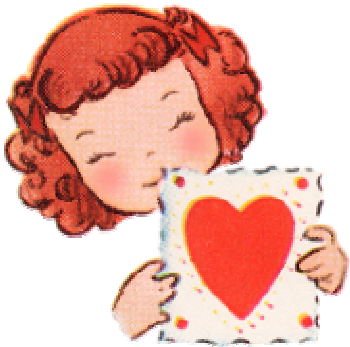
Greetings from your Chapter MEC,

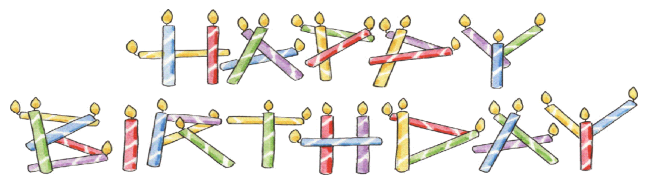

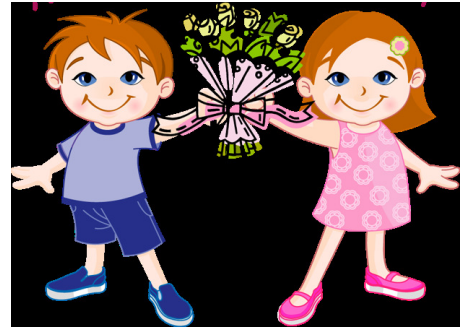

Don't forget the Operations Meeting, January 27, 2018 at the Ramada Convention Center, Burlington, NC. Kicking off another great year.

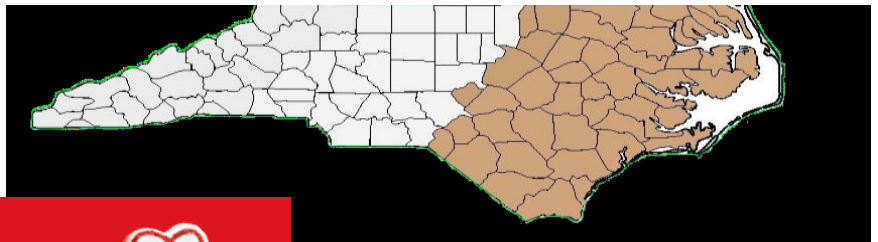

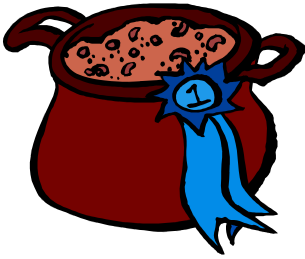
