Our Time here is short enough! There is no need to speed it up!

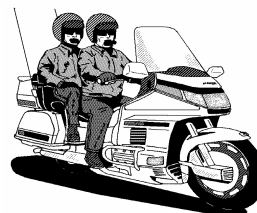

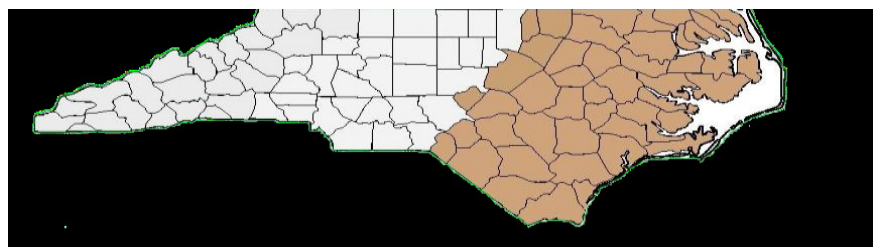
