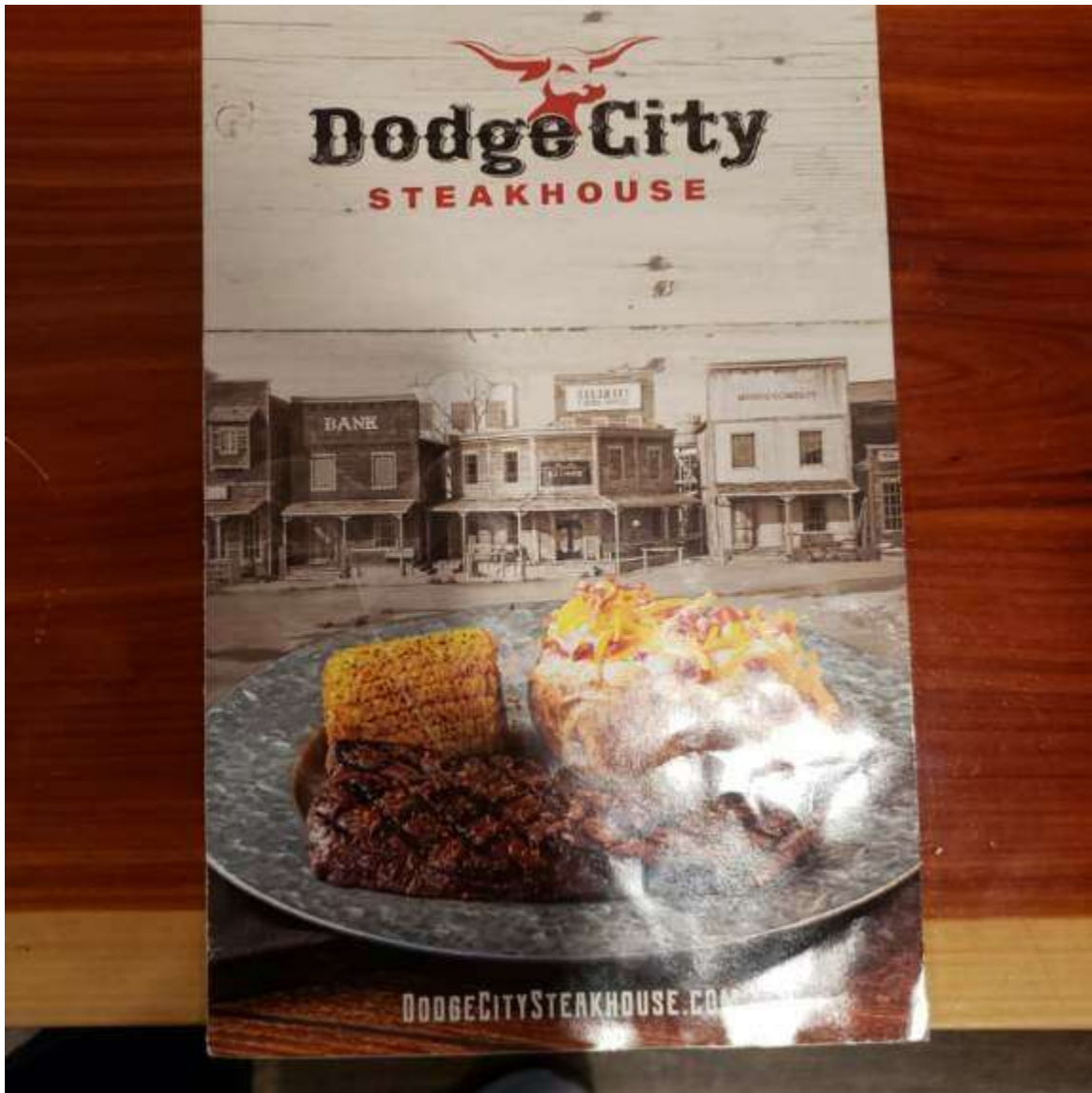

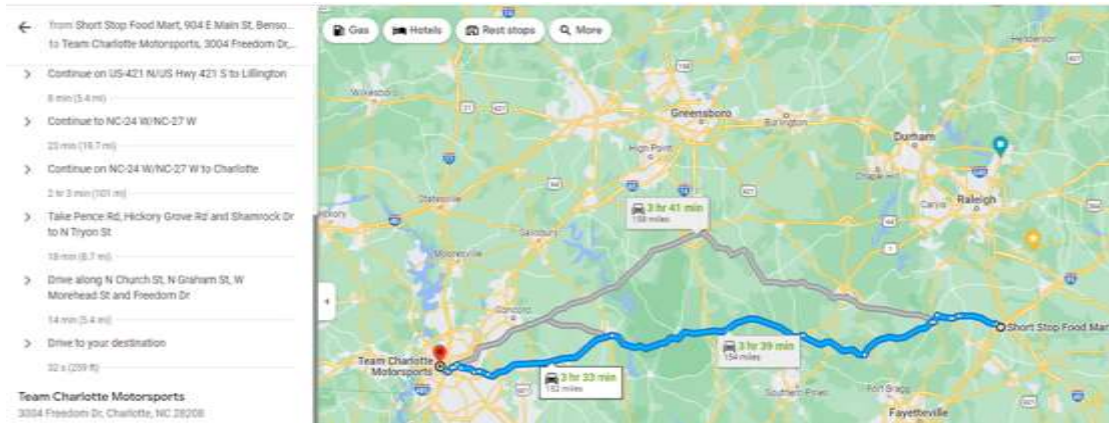

SAFETY

Thank you to NC-E2 Elizabeth City's Lee Fortier (GWRRA Master Tour Rider and Former CD) for giving C2 permission to use information from his article in E2's April 2022 Newsletter. C2's Newsletter Editors reworked/edited Lee's thoughts to save space but he deserves all the credit for the following important reminders.

Lee reminded us of the importance of being able to see, being able to be seen and the importance of protective gear (how being properly dressed can keep riders from being badly injured). Yes, even though storage space is limited on motorcycles (2 and 3 wheelers) we would all likely agree with Lee that having first-aid supplies and equipment on hand is essential (for our own use and to help others). Lee's first-aid supplies -- "My old stand-by is a well-worn, soft, used, 'clean' T-shirt that I have washed and bleached. I then cut it so that it makes as big a 'square' as possible. I then fold it so that it fits into a pint or quart zip-loc baggie. This can be used as a wipe, a bandage, or even a sling if needed. A small roll of medical tape can be used to secure the bandage and apply compression to the wound. Next up is a product called Quik-Clot, available on Amazon. This is a bandage that contains a clotting agent and is specifically designed to stop blood flow by providing a clotting agent. Highly recommend you carry one of these on your bike at all times. Remember, compression and elevation of the wound whenever practical to do so — and once you apply a bandage—do NOT remove it. If it becomes blood soaked, simply place another bandage on top of the first one. For smaller wounds, a small supply of 4X4 non-stick bandage pads and a small supply of regular bandages should take care of most things you can accomplish on the road while waiting for EMT help to arrive. If you still have space, some Tylenol or aspirin, antiseptic lotion or salve for the wound, some scissors (to get to the wound), and a small supply of hand-wipe packets for cleaning the area."

We agree with Lee, of course, and hope it never happens but if any of us are nearby when an incident does happen, we may be very thankful that we and/or those around us are prepared to help ourselves and a fellow rider in need.

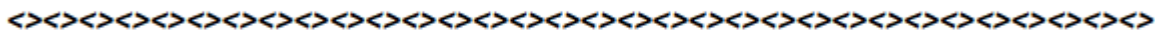

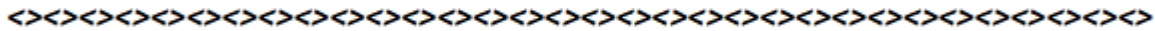

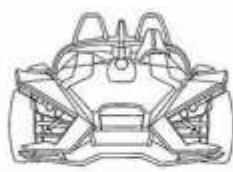
Wings Over Carolina Western Region Ride
